Please note: We encourage those men who are mature in the faith, gifted and led to do so, to exercise their gifts.

Start a study, encourage, disciple, spread the Gospel.

We encourage the Women who are mature to exercise their gifts and use their talents to the glory of our Lord with a few caveats (women should not teach or exercise authority over men—1 Tim 2:12, and older women are directed by Scripture as to what they should teach

younger women—Titus 2:3-5). Remember this: everyone here is to examine all things and search the Scriptures to see if what you teach or proclaim is so (Acts 17:11.) As

the Spirit develops elders among us, you will begin to recognize them by their character, soundness of doctrine and defense of the faith. While never "lording it over" anyone, elders are required by the Word to correct teaching that is contrary to sound doctrine—Titus 1:9)

Order of Service

Date: Any Given Sunday

- Someone, or several someones, or all, will most likely pray
- We may or may not have a song or two
- We may or may not have a teaching
- We will definitely read some Scripture (but we may not know beforehand what we will read)
- If there is praise, we will hear praise
- If there is need, there will be sharing
- We may or may not hear what some of the fellowship have learned since we all last met, or some insight or wisdom they have received
- If the previous point actually occurs, there may be some insight or commentary by those who are discerning
- In any case, everything will be interactive, hopefully
- Discussions will probably continue while the supper is set out
- Bread will be broken with a blessing and passed around in remembrance of the Lord's broken body, and anticipation of His return
- A meal will be eaten, discussions and remembrances most likely continuing
- The cup will be shared with a blessing, remembering the shed blood of our Lord, and His promise to drink of the vine with us in His kingdom
- Some will likely leave at this point, while others will continue to fellowship

Please note: with the exception of the Bread—Supper—Cup order, the items noted may occur in a completely different order from that listed above.
